**FROM THE DEACON'S DESK.....**

Most Sundays our second reading is said to be a letter from St. Paul. So, did St. Paul write all those letters? When talking about biblical authors, we can't compare it to modern authorship. Ancient writers often wrote supporting existing schools of thought. Most scholars attribute at least 7 of the 14 letters to St. Paul because they all share the same style, personality, theology, and viewpoint. Three other letters reflect Paul's ideas but also reveal another writer's style, perhaps a student of his. The remaining four letters are debated but usually thought as non-Pauline, but contain much of the same theology. Even though the authorship of Paul's letters is debated, even by the early church fathers, they are in the Bible nonetheless. We might honor the judgment of our fathers in faith that these words are truly God-inspired, even if their author sometimes remains a mystery.

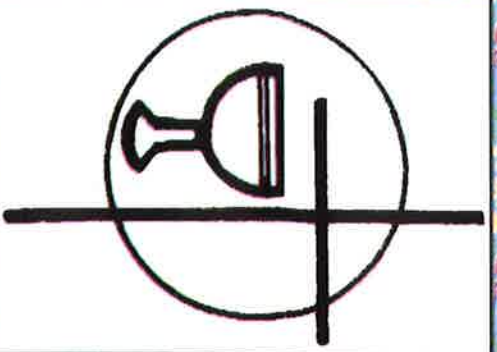

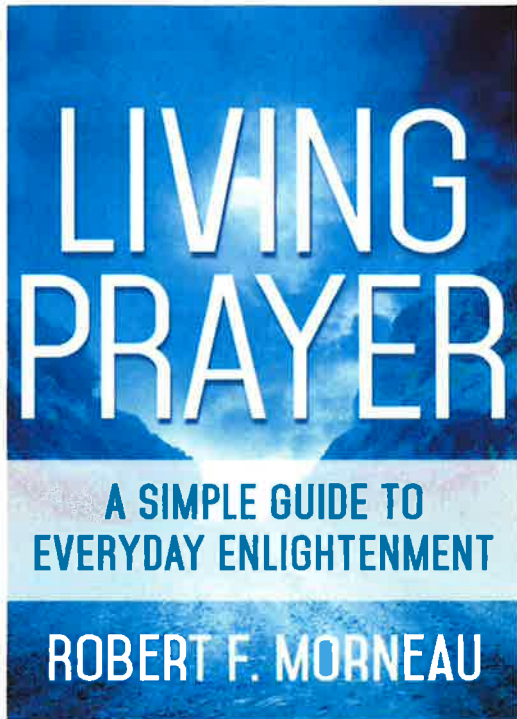
