**FROM THE DEACON'S DESK.....**

A couple of weeks ago when I stopped in at St. John Bosco school to pick up the Dr. Seuss book I used in my homily, I had a chance to chat with a couple of teachers as they were getting their classrooms ready. One of the teachers gave me DVD to review that she is planning to use this year for middle school religion class. It was a DVD on the beauty of the Mass and ways we can better appreciate it. One way is to look at Mass as a true encounter with God. Instead of passively listening to the readings (or even zoning out), actively immerse yourself in them. We can do this by preparing ourselves beforehand by reading the scriptures ahead of time. You can find them at [www.usccb.org/bible/readings](http://www.usccb.org/bible/readings). During the Eucharist we can make it personal by acknowledging that Christ would have made the same sacrifice if it were only for you! We can remind ourselves that Jesus really did this for me! 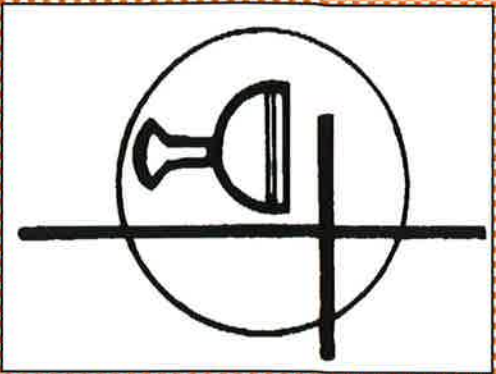
