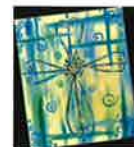

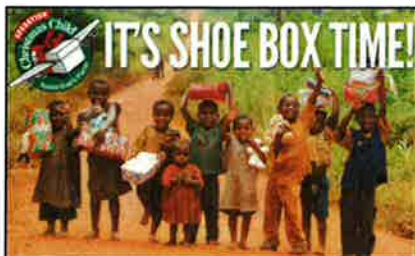
Come join your parish family in packing shoeboxes full of gifts and sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with children around the world!
