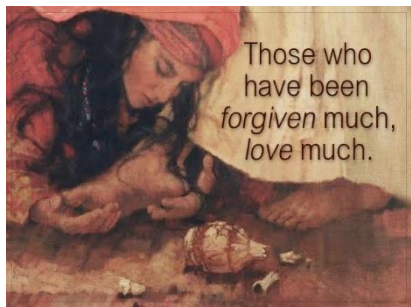
**On Fire for the Lord**
