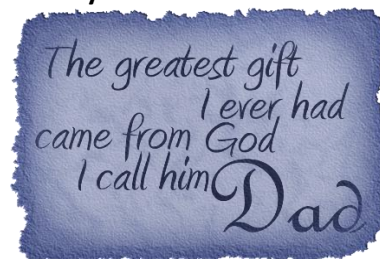
PARISH NEWS

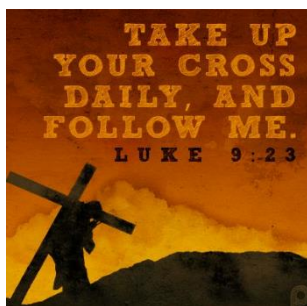
