**Missionary Cooperation Appeal**

Next weekend we will have Rev. Luis Carlos De Leon a priest of the Fraternity here making the appeal. He was ordained a priest in 1990 in Guatemala. He has served in mission in USA, Guatemala and Italy. At this time Father DeLeon serves as the Prefect of Formation at the seminary of the Missionary Fraternity of Mary in Guatemala City. The Annual Missionary Cooperation Appeal supports the Missionary Fraternity of Mary of Guatemala. It begun in 1981 as a youth ministry with seven young men, and was established as a Society in 1990. Since then it has grown to over 150 ordained priests serving 64 missions in 31 dioceses in 11 countries. Currently there are approximately 170 seminarians in various stages of formation at the seminary in Guatemala. These mission sites are established where there are no clergy available. Edge start up dates for all grades: Wed., September 28<sup>th</sup> from 6pm-7:15pm at Corpus Christi.

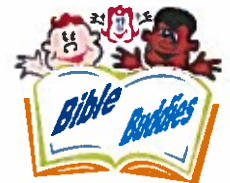
