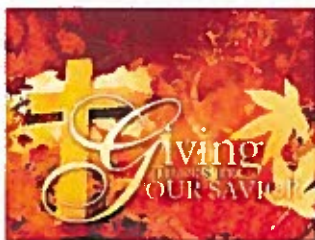

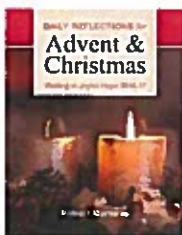
Advent Wreaths & Candles
