FROM THE DEACON'S DESK.....

Last week I saw my older brother in the hospital. He was a bit concerned when a priest came in to anoint him. When he was growing up it was called 'extreme unction' and reserved for those who had reached the point of death. At Vatican II, the Church recognized that when Jesus sent His disciples to heal the sick, it was not limited to the dying so they changed the name of the Sacrament to 'Anointing of the Sick'. Now anyone who is suffering from serious illness is welcomed to receive this Sacrament in the hope of gaining the Lord's grace of healing. Another term many are not familiar with is 'Viaticum', Latin for 'provisions for a journey'. It is Holy Communion to a person who is dying, offering hope for eternal life. Viaticum adds the words 'May the Lord Jesus Christ protects you and lead you to eternal life'. Praise God my brother is doing better. God willing he will not need Viaticum any time soon.
