## Life Teen Mission Trip 2015 \*\* Mississippi June 13-21

Dear parishioners,

Some people have suggested that young people would be more interested in the Church if the Holy Father would “unwind a bit and lighten up.” As a youth minister, I completely disagree. I think it’s the Church’s refusal to water down the truth that draws them to Christ and to His mission of reaching out and serving the poor. Think about it: we have nearly 50 people going to Mississippi this summer to help rebuild from the devastating effects of Hurricane Katrina. It would be SO much easier for them to stay home, sleep in, watch TV, and hang out with friends. Instead, they are choosing to live in less than desirable conditions for a week: heat, humidity, cold food, little sleep, and blisters. They aren’t making the trip because it’s easy; they are making this trip because they want to bring the message of hope to the hurting.

Pope Emeritus Benedict said to the young people of the world: “You were not created for comfort but for greatness.” Our youth are not looking for someone to offer them an easy life; they are willing to be uncomfortable. Mission trips are life changing because our youth find out what life is really all about: washing each other’s feet (John 13).

You are invited to be part of our mission trip by purchasing stock. We created mission boards that have 100 squares and you donated the amount of the square you picked (if you pick square 3, you pay \$3). Thank you can’t even begin to cover how grateful we are for your donations and support. Our youth have been working hard earning money to go--this isn’t a free ride for them. It’s people like you that make it possible. Thank you so very much.

Our goal is to fill all 100 squares. WE DID IT LAST YEAR, LET’S DO IT AGAIN! That amount would be \$5050. **ANY amount is appreciated—honestly a dollar goes a long way!** Please fill out the bottom part of this and send it to Corpus Christi (or drop it off in the collection basket at any parish) if you would like to help us reach our goal. All donations are tax deductible and get recorded at the parish in which you belong. If you become a Stockholder, you will receive a thank you card from the trip, and an opportunity to come to our Stockholder’s dinner in August so you can hear all about the trip. We also take all names and pray for them by name during our journey.
