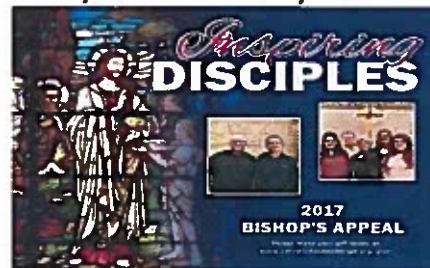

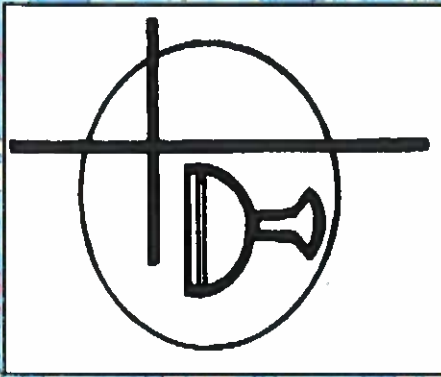


**CHRIST CHILD SOCIETY**

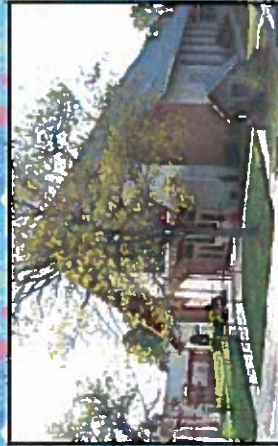
