150 Year History of Diocese of G.B.

In 1900, Catholics on the west side of Sturgeon Bay would travel across a toll bridge to get to the bay's east side for Mass at St. Joseph Church. Annually, the tolls could cost as much as \$400., a financial burden for each of the 51 families who made the weekly trek. The pastor of St. Joseph, Msgr. Alphonse Broens, contacted the bishop to ask for a new parish on the west side of the bay. With the bishop's blessing, Msgr. Broens offered a tract of land he owned for the new parish in 1904. Corpus Christi's first Mass was on Easter Sunday, April 3, 1904 at the Sawyer Opera Hall on Oak Street, because the church had not been built yet. 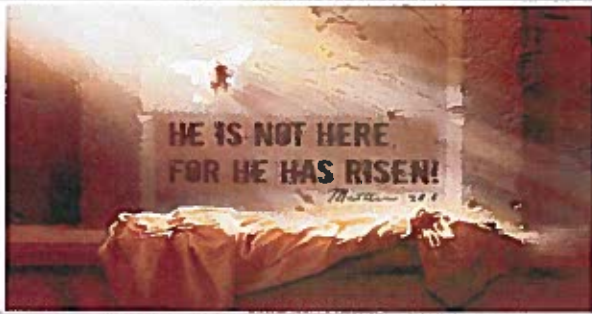


Bishop's Appeal

Informative Books from Knights of Columbus

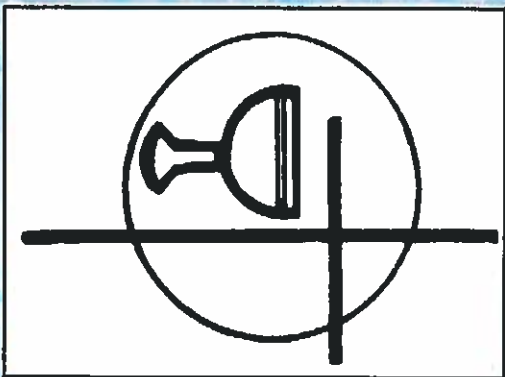
