A few years ago Father Carl Schmitt and Dr. Amy Fogarty felt a passionate need to initiate a program that would support those students and their families who wanted to attend SJB but were in a financial situation where without help that would not be a reality. It was their belief that money should not prevent families from enrolling who desired a faith based and academically enriching program for their children. It was with their foresight and many generous donors in the past that last year we were able to financially assist 29 children.

What to give? This month I would like to focus on sustaining those donations and increasing them if possible. Contributions can be made on a monthly or yearly basis
